Project Yangon is an overseas community service project organised by 18 Year 1 and 2 students from the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, NUS, to Yangon, Myanmar. 2020 will be our 9th trip to Yangon.

Our beneficiaries

We serve the villagers of Village 17 in Shwe Pyi Thar township, including many that were forcibly relocated after a fire in their previous township resulting in many whom are financially unstable and unaware of the importance of good health. We aim to improve the health of the villagers in Shwe Pyi Thar through a series of health screening and education initiatives.



How you can help

Doctors are involved in providing **consultations** during our General Health Screenings, located in Shwe Pyi Thar, across 2 days in May during our Main trip. As well as the **prescription of medication** and **issuing of referrals**.

Since our last trip in May 2019, we set up a new initiative, Mobile Health Screening, where we conduct home visits to villagers whom are unable to come for our General Health Screening. Doctors are involved in following us from **door to door** to provide check ups for these villagers.

We are looking for ophthalmologists and generalists to join us! Burmese and burmese-speaking doctors are welcomed too.

We will leave our hotel at 7am and reach back around 530pm on both screening days.
